

22nd Annual NJWGSC Undergraduate Research Colloquium Friday, March 27, 2026 Hosted by The College of New Jersey Call for Papers & Projects Submission Deadline: Feb 6, 2026

Attention faculty! Each New Jersey College/University is permitted to submit *up to three* undergraduate papers or projects for presentation at the Colloquium.

- ✓ Academic research/scholarly papers*
- ✓ Activism/Advocacy (individuals or groups)*
- ✓ Creative expression/performance (individuals or groups)*

*Please note the following guidelines as you gather and finalize submissions:

- Advocacy/Activism: a paper submission must be included detailing the work involved. A video or website is also acceptable in addition to the paper submission.
- Creative Expression/Performance/Art Exhibition: students must include a written "artist's statement" of project or performance (if submission isn't narrative/written expression). If appropriate for the medium, include photographs or video.
- Academic Research/Scholarly Papers: Typically, papers submitted are 10-30 pages in length. All are based on original research of some kind. If you are unsure, please inquire, see below.

*Please Note: Digital projects accepted in all categories

Each institution should collect papers/projects nominated by faculty and select the *three* to be submitted to the Colloquium. All submitted papers/projects will be presented at the Colloquium.

Formatting Instructions:

- Cover Page. Each submission must include a separate Cover Page attachment sent along with the submission attachment. On the Cover Page, please include the author(s)/artist(s)/Performer(s) Names, Paper/Project Title, Course Title, Professor's Name for which the submission was created, and the Institution Name.
- Remove author-identifying information from the actual submission itself except for the paper/project title on the first page (for judging).
